I am a woman of child-bearing age and have access to and/or work in radiation areas. I have read the US Nuclear Regulatory Agency Regulatory Guide 8.13, "Instruction Concerning Prenatal Radiation Exposure", and the appendix to the guide, "Frequently Asked Questions". I was given the opportunity to ask questions after reading this material. In addition I have received information concerning the risks of prenatal radiation exposure in oral form from my supervisor (or other qualified person \_\_\_\_\_)

I understand that the fetus may be more sensitive to harm from radiation than adults, and that for this reason the occupational exposure of the pregnant woman should not exceed 0.5 rem of radiation during the term of pregnancy. I understand that the first three months of pregnancy are the most important, and once pregnant I must decide quickly whether or not to reduce or discontinue working in radiation areas.

I know the name of the authorized user under whose supervision I work in radiation areas. I also know the name of the Radiation Safety Officer. I understand that I have the right to ask these people additional questions at any time concerning possible health risks for women who are exposed to radiation during pregnancy.
